

Standards for University Use of Cibolo Preserve

While at Cibolo Preserve (CP), University (UTSA), its faculty, staff, students and representatives, agree:

- a. To use reasonable care to avoid damage or impairment to CP and to all wildlife, natural values, structures and improvements on CP.
- b. Not to kill, chase, or intentionally disturb any wildlife, with the exception of immediate human safety concerns.
- c. Not to collect wildlife, except for scientific and educational purposes and then, only to the extent as expressly authorized by CP in writing.
- d. Not to litter on CP in any manner.
- e. Not to collect artifacts or otherwise make archeological digs except with the express, written, advance approval of CP.
- f. To take any and all standard precautions which UTSA would typically take in conducting educational programming. UTSA shall be responsible for bringing communication equipment (cellular telephones or other equipment) for emergencies or other communication needs. UTSA acknowledges that cellular service may not be available on all areas of CP. UTSA also acknowledges that CP may not have communication equipment and that CP is not responsible for providing means of communication.
- g. To remove from CP, in a lawful manner and at the end of each visit, any and all trash, debris, and any other materials resulting from UTSA's activities.
- h. At the completion of a Project, to restore CP to its original condition as much as reasonably practicable.
- i. To treat CP and its habitat in a manner compatible with CP'S preservation, conservation, and restoration objectives.
- j. Not to leave any equipment on CP without the express, written, advance approval of CP. Any equipment left on CP shall be at the sole risk of the Project and UTSA.
- k. To keep confidential the location of CP except in communicating with UTSA faculty, staff and students who are authorized by UTSA to participate in an approved Project at CP.
- l. To sign in daily at the gate box located at CP when accessing CP.
- m. To prohibit any person under 18 years of age to access CP.
- n. A baseline study, as per The University of Texas at San Antonio description, will be conducted as part of the activities on the property.
