

## Limited Submission Announcement

A limited submission opportunity is available from the Johnson & Johnson Early Career Scholars Program and has been posted to the [UTSA Limited Submission webpage](#).

### **Johnson & Johnson Women in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Manufacturing and Design (WiSTEM<sup>2</sup>D) Scholars Program**

The Johnson & Johnson Scholars Award Program aims to fuel the development of female STEM<sup>2</sup>D leaders and feed the STEM<sup>2</sup>D talent pipeline by awarding and sponsoring women at critical points in their research careers, in each of the STEM<sup>2</sup>D disciplines: Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Manufacturing and Design.

The awards will fund one woman per discipline who has completed her advanced degree, who is working as an assistant professor and who is not yet tenured at an accredited university or design institution. The goal is to fuel the research passion of the awarded women and inspire career paths in their respective STEM<sup>2</sup>D fields.

#### **Eligibility**

- Female, non-tenured assistant professors or faculty members in equivalent positions in one of the eligible STEM<sup>2</sup>D disciplines: Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Manufacturing and Design.

The female scholar should have a minimum degree for the appropriate field:

- Science; M.D., Ph.D.
- Technology; Ph.D.
- Engineering; Ph.D.
- Math; M.S., Ph.D.
- Manufacturing; Ph.D.
- Design; M.A., M.S., MDes, MArch, MFA, MLA, Ph.D.

#### **Application Limit**

UTSA is eligible to submit up to **6 applications**. One application per STEM<sup>2</sup>D discipline: Science, Technology, Engineering, Math, Manufacturing and Design.

#### **Award Amount**

3-year award in the gross amount of \$150,000.

#### **Cost Share Requirement**

Cost sharing is not a requirement for this program.

#### **Internal Evaluation Criteria**

The attached review matrix will be utilized for internal review/scoring. Pre-proposals should be responsive to these criteria.

- (1) Applicant's Curriculum Vitae (3-page max, PDF)
- (2) Research Summary (1,000-word max plus one page of images, PDF) *Note: Applicants should be mindful of J&J's mission statement ([OUR Credo](#)) in preparation of their research summary.*
