

## Limited Submissions Announcement

A limited submission opportunity is available from the National Endowment for the Humanities and has been posted to the [UTSA Limited Submission Opportunities webpage](#).

### NEH Summer Stipends Program Overview

Summer Stipends support individuals pursuing advanced research that is of value to humanities scholars, general audiences, or both.

Eligible projects usually result in articles, monographs, books, digital materials and publications, archaeological site reports, translations, or editions. Projects must not result solely in the collection of data; instead, they must also incorporate analysis and interpretation.

Summer Stipends support continuous full-time work on a humanities project for a period of two consecutive months. Summer Stipends support projects at any stage of development.

### Eligibility

- Applicants with college or university affiliations must be nominated by their institutions.
- Non-tenure-track faculty, adjunct faculty, staff, retired faculty, community college faculty, and independent scholars are exempt from nomination.
- U.S. citizens OR Foreign nationals who have been living in the United States or its jurisdictions for at least the three years immediately preceding the application deadline.
- Individuals who have either held or received a major fellowship or research award or its equivalent within the three academic years prior to the deadline are eligible.

### Application Limit

Each institution may nominate **two** faculty members.

### Award Amount

\$6,000 for two consecutive months.

### Cost Share Requirement

NEH Summer Stipends are awarded to individuals, not to institutions. They do not require cost sharing and do not include indirect costs.

### Internal Evaluation Criteria

The attached review matrix will be utilized for internal review/scoring. Pre-proposals should be responsive to these criteria.
