A limited submission opportunity is available from the Searle Scholars Program and has been posted to the [UTSA Limited Submission Opportunities webpage](#).

[Searle Scholars Program Overview](#)

The Searle Scholars Program was designed to support the independent research of outstanding individuals who are in the first or second year of their first appointment at the assistant professor level, and whose current appointment is a tenure-track position.

The Searle Scholars Program Scientific Advisory Board is primarily interested in the potential of applicants to make innovative and high-impact contributions to research over an extended period of time.

Applicants for the 2020 competition (awards which will be activated on July 1, 2020) are expected to be pursuing independent research careers in **biochemistry, cell biology, genetics, immunology, neuroscience, pharmacology, and related areas in chemistry, medicine, and the biological sciences**.

Potential applicants are encouraged to examine the research interests of [present](#) and [former](#) Searle Scholars on this website.

Eligibility

Candidates must have their appointment as an independent investigator at the assistant professor level on or after July 1, 2018. The appointment must be their first tenure-track position (or its nearest equivalent) at an invited institution.

Application Limit

One nomination is allowed per invited institution.

Award Amount

\$300,000 for a three-year period.

Internal Evaluation Criteria

The attached review matrix will be utilized for internal review/scoring. Pre-proposals should be responsive to these criteria.
