### **Application Limit**

Organizations may only submit **one (1)** request in a 12-month period.

### **Award Amount**

The grant range is from \$20,000 to \$75,000 over a one-year period.

### **Internal Evaluation Criteria**

The attached review matrix will be utilized for internal review/scoring. Pre-proposals should be responsive to these criteria.
